

Poster Preparation Guidelines

- Posters should not be larger than 90 (horizontal) x 110 (vertical) cm and should be in a single paper.
- All margins should be 2 cm at least.
- Title font size should be 60 p, bold, and should not exceed two lines.
- For the author names and affiliations (including street address) should be written in bold and the font sizes should be 30 p and 20 p, respectively. Subtitles should be written in 24 p, bold; and the main text is to be 16-18 p.
- Name of the presenting author should be underlined. His/her e-mail address should be written in 20 p and just below the affiliations line.
- Two column text and embedded figures are preferred.
- Posters are preferred to include Introduction, Materials & Method, Results & Discussions, and Conclusion subsections; references should optionally be listed below the text in smaller font size.
- There is no limitation in colour selection; the colourful figures and photos are preferred for visual quality. Font style in the figures are recommended to be as same as the main text and easy readable. Figures should be large enough to see from a reasonable distance.
